

# Year 1 History: Explorers

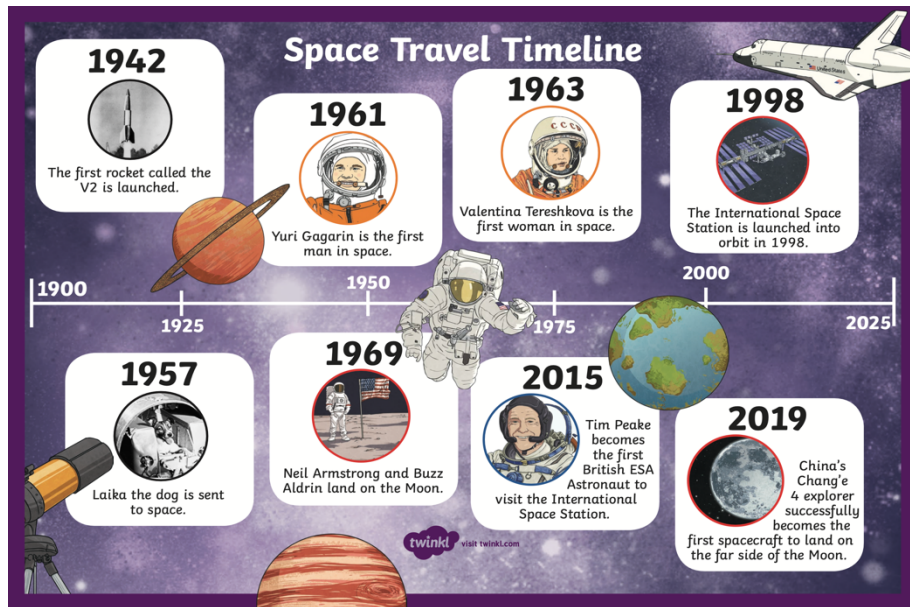
## 1. Key Knowledge

1	Christopher Columbus was an explorer. The king and queen of Spain gave him money to sail west, he landed in the Americas.
2	In 1492 Christopher Columbus set sail with 3 ships. When the new lands were discovered Spain sent soldiers to take over the new lands.
3	Treasures like gold were taken and Spain became very rich. The people who lived on the islands were not treated well and some were taken as slaves.
4	In 1969 Neil Armstrong landed on the moon, he was the first man on the moon.
5	When Neil Armstrong landed on the moon he said 'one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind'.
6	Major Tim Peake was the first British astronaut to visit the International Space Station in 2015.

<b>Impact</b>	A strong effect or influence.
<b>Explorer</b>	A person who explores a new or unfamiliar area
<b>Voyage</b>	A long journey involving travel by sea or by space.
<b>Astronaut</b>	A person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft.
<b>International Space Station</b>	A large space craft that orbits the Earth. Astronauts can live on there for many months.
<b>Orbit</b>	The curved path of a spacecraft round a star, planet or moon.
